Smile Train for a few years now. I had discussed with my parents that I would try and give a purpose to my photography, and Smile Train offered such a nice opportunity to do so.


"I have spent time in India with Smile Train's patients, doctors, staff and volunteers network, and the proceeds from this book are a small contribution to support and recognise their efforts."
